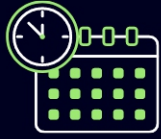

Originally from Torbay, Newfoundland, Carl Dymond joined the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) as a Communicator Research Operator and was posted to CFS Leitrim, where he supported military operations in Afghanistan, Libya, as well as other missions around the world. With a focus on Signals Intelligence (SIGINT), Carl has been instrumental in combatting insurgencies, terrorism, and the protection of CAF personnel and allies worldwide.

Following the CAF, he built a highly successful company, The Dymond Group of Companies, developing the largest bulk cargo unmanned aircraft in the world from the ground up.

He then went on to create Greater NL Partnership, his Newfoundland-based company which has recently purchased an ICAO class, international airport in Stephenville, Newfoundland, now named the Stephenville Dymond International Airport (SDIA). SDIA will be the base of operations and technological hub for testing the aircraft, while also accepting commercial flights to and from Western Newfoundland.

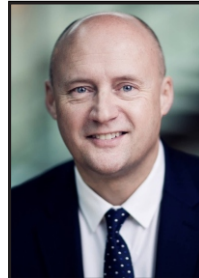
